LOUISVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR SUMMER BASKETBALL LEAGUE

Due to COVID 19, we are required to have specific site guidelines. Please review these carefully prior to arriving at Louisville High School

All individuals participating in the basketball league MUST bring the following with them:

- 1. Bottle of water prefilled. A suggestion: at least one gallon container.
- 2. Extra Mask
- 3. Hand Sanitizer
- 4. Disinfecting Wipes (small package)
- 5. Own towel and personal items

Entrance and Exit Strategies for Louisville High School Campus

The entrance/exit strategies for the basketball league at Louisville High School are as follows when coming on the campus:

If the athletes are being dropped off by their parents:

- The athletes will be dropped off in the lower parking lot
- The athlete will proceed to the gym, where they will be checked-in by the coaching staff.

If athletes are driving themselves:

- The athlete must park in the lower parking lot
- The athlete will proceed to the gym, where they will be checked-in by the coaching staff.
- The athlete must return immediately to their cars after the league.

Pre-Match Screening

All Louisville athletes, coaches and staff will complete their health screening at home before coming to the basketball game.

Upon completion of the screening, the individual will receive an email stating whether they are clear to enter the school campus.

Coaches and staff that are cleared to enter campus will show their email to the security guard at the entrance to the campus.

Visiting schools' coaches will screen their athletes before entering the school campus, using their school apps, guidelines and protocols.

Pre-Game Conference

For the pregame conference, there needs to be a limit of attendees to the referee and the head coach from each team with each coach standing on the center circle on each side of the division line.

All individuals should maintain a social distance of 6-feet or greater at the center circle.

There will be no handshakes prior to and following the Pre-game conference.

Team Benches

The bench should be limited to athletes and coaching staff in order to observe social distancing of 6- feet or greater.

Additional chairs or rows may be added to allow bench personnel to observe social distancing of 6-feet or greater.

All individuals not in the game should wear a face covering.

Substitution Procedures

All players should maintain social distancing of 6-feet between the second referee and limit contact between players when substituting.

Officials' Table

Before the game and at half-time the score table must be sanitized.

The table should be sufficiently away from the sideline to allow for additional space for substitutes.

Only essential personnel which includes home team scorer and shot clock timer should be at the score table with a distance of 6-feet between individuals.

The visiting team personnel (scorer, statisticians, etc.) are not deemed essential personnel and need to find an alternative location.

All personnel at the score table must wear face coverings.

Pre and Post-Game Ceremony

Both teams will suspend handshakes prior to and following pregame conference as well as post-game handshakes.

Replace post-game handshakes with a social distance acknowledgement of the team's choosing.

Basketball Sanitation

The game ball given to officials is to be sanitized as recommended by the ball manufacturer and not used for warm-ups.

The game ball will be cleaned at the end of each quarter.

Spectators

All spectators must wear masks at all times in the gym.
